

Snowline Joint Unified School District

Phelan, CA

Project background:

Snowline Joint USD leveraged alternative financing to make modernization and energy efficiency improvements to facilities without raising taxes.

Funding:

- · Energy savings used to offset costs
- CA Proposition 39 state funding
- · Lease purchase agreement

Solution highlights:

- District-wide interior/exterior lighting upgraded to LED technology
- Lighting controls improve energy efficiency
- IT power management system shuts off networked devices when not in use
- Gymnasium ceiling modification improves visibility and aesthetics
- Demand-management equipment and software limits peak demand charges



Results:

The two-phased project reduced utility costs by 28%, saving nearly \$7.8 million over the life of the performance contract.

Madison County Schools

Huntsville, AL

Project background:

Having reached its bonded debt capacity, Madison County Schools opted for a capital recovery and reinvestment program to fund critical facility improvements from the resulting energy savings.

- Water fixture commissioning/upgrades save millions of gallons of water



Results:

The largest K-12 project of its kind undertaken in Alabama to date, the district will generate \$40 million in capital savings over 20 years, reducing utility costs by 30 percent and energy use by 40 percent.

Comanche, TX

Project background:
